**Exemption of Site Appraisal from Site Appraisal Committee for furnace upto 500 Kg capacity per heat falls in non designated area.**

In the 29<sup>th</sup> meeting of CSA-cum SAC decision on the item No. 29.28 on the subject cited above was taken as under.

After detailed discussions, it was decided that the site falls in Agriculture/Rural area (Non designated Area). The exemption may be granted as per the following procedure:-

1. The entrepreneur will obtain certificate from the District Town Planner to the effect that the site does not falls in the boundary of Master Plan of any city/town or any other controlled area.
2. The entrepreneur will then obtain the certificate from the District Forest Officer to the effect that no forest area is affected and there is no violation of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for the establishment of the proposed industry.
3. The entrepreneur will also obtain NOC from the concerned Local Body with regard to the fire fighting arrangements.

The entrepreneur will apply to Director of Factories for NOC after obtaining the above consents.
