- (1) The Factories Act, 1948
- (2) The Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958.
- (3) Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.
- (4) The payment of Wages Act, 1936.
- (5) The minimum Wages Act, 1948.
- (6) The Punjab Industrial Establishments (National and Festival Holidays, and Casual and Sick Leave) Act. 1965.
- (7) The Motor Transport Workers Act, 1961
- (8) The payment of Bonus Act. 1965.
