No. S.O. 71/C.A. 16/26/S.3/83.—In continuation of Government of Punjab, Department of Labour and Employment, Notification No. G.S.R. 164/C.A. 16/26/S. 3/82, dated the 7th December, 1982, and in partial modification of Government of Punjab, Department of Labour and Employment Notification No. S.O. 29/C.A. 16/26/S. 3/86, dated the 5th. August, 1986, and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Central Act No. XVI of 1926) and all other powers enabling him this behalf, the President of India is pleased to appoint the Additional Labour Commissioner, Punjab to be the Additional Registrar of Trade Unions for the whole of the State of Punjab for the purpose of exercising and discharging under the superintendence and direction of the Registrar, of Trade Unions for the state Punjab, all the powers and functions of the Registrar of Trade Unions under the aforesaid Act.

(2)2000.—With reference to Government of Punjab, Department of Labour and Employment, Notification No. G.S.R. 49/C.A. 16/26/Ss. 29 and 30/Amd. 2000, dated the 30th May, 2000, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Act No. 16 of 1926), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following regulations further to amend the Punjab Trade Union Regulations, 1927, namely

Regulations

1. These regulations may be called the Punjab Trade Union (First Amendment) Regulations, 2000.
2. In the Punjab Trade Union Regulations, 1927 in regulation 8. for the word and figure “Rs. 5”, the word and figures “Rs. 100” shall be substituted.
