NO. 7048-V-Lab-II-63/18426.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Motor Transport Workers Act 1961, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the Labour Commissioner, Punjab to be the Chief Inspector with in the local limits of whole of the state of Punjab.

- (8) All the Labour Inspectors Grade-II in the State.
- (9) All Factory Inspectors in the State.

No. G.S.R. 82/C.A. 27/61/S. 40/Amd (13)/98—With reference to Government of Punjab, Department of Labour and Employment, Notification No. G.S. R. 38/C.A. 27/61/S. 40/Amd./98 dated the 27th April, 1998, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Motor Transport Workers Act, 1961 (Central Act No. 27 of 1981), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Motor Transport Workers Rules, 1963, namely :—

**RULES**

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Motor Transport Workers (First Amendment) Rules, 1998.

2. In the Punjab Motor Transport Workers Rules, 1963 (hereinafter referred to the said rules), in rules 24, in sub-rule (2), for the words “ten rupees” the words “thirty rupees” shall be substituted.

3. In the said rules, in Schedule I for No (ii), the following Note shall be substituted, namely :—

“(ii) The minimum cost of summer uniform, winter uniform and chappals (Gurgabi) shall respectively be five hundred twenty five rupees, four hundred seventy five rupees and two hundred thirty seven rupees”.

(12)/94.—With reference to Government of Punjab, Department of Labour and Employment Notification No. G.S.R. 75/C A. 27/61/S. 40/Amd./93, dated the 23rd September 1993, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Motor Transport Worker Act, 1961 (Central Act No. 27 of 1961), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Motor Transport Workers Rules, 1963 namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Motor Transport Workers (First Amendment) Rules, 1994.

2. In the Punjab Motor Transport Workers Rules, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 5, for the existing table, the following shall be substituted :—

3. In the said rules, in rule 7, in subrule (3), for the words “five rupees”, the words “fifty rupees” shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, in rule 11, for the words “five rupees” the words “fifty rupees” shall be substituted.

5. In the said rules, in rule 12, in sub-rule (1), for the figure and words “087 Labour and Employment, (a) receipts under Labour Laws”, the figures and words, “0230—Labour and Employment 01—Labour (a) receipts under various Laws” shall be substituted.
