

1. THE PUNJAB LAND REVENUE ACT, 1887
NOTIFICATION
THE 25TH JUNE, 19921

No. S. O. 44/P. A. 27/1888/S. 17/92—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of the sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Punjab Act No. 17 of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab, is pleased to confer on all the Assistant Labour Commissioners in the State of Punjab, the powers conferrable on an Assistant Collector of the First Grade under sections 68, 69 and 70 of the said Act, so far as these are necessary for the recovery of dues recoverables as arrears of land revenue under the following Acts and to direct that such powers shall be exercised by them within the limits of their respective jurisdiction :-

1. The Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.
2. The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972.
3. The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965.
4. The Working Journalists and other News-Paper Employees (Conditions of Services) and Miscel's aneous Provisions Act, 1955.
5. The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976.
6. The Punjab Industiral Housing Act, 1956.
7. The Punjab Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1965.

2. THE PUNJAB LAND REVENUE ACT, 1887
NOTIFICATION
THE 28TH MAY, 1991

No. S. O. 27/P. A. 17/1887/S/27/91—In supersession of Government of Punjab, Department of Revenue Notification No. CSR. 8/P.A. 171887/S, 27/87, dated the 3rd February, 1987 No. S. O. 73, P.A. 17/1887/S. 27/88, Dated the 21st September, 1988 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 27 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Punjab Act No. 17 of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the President of India is pleased to confer on all the Labour-cum-Conciliation Officers in the State of Punjab, the powers conferrable on an Assistant Collector of the First Grade under sections 68, 69 and 70 of the said Act, so far as these are necessary for the recovery of dues recoverables as arrears of land revenue under the following Acts and to direct that such powers shall be exercised by them within the limits of their respective jurisdiction :—
