RULES

- **1.** (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Minimum Wages (First Amendment) Rules, 2011.
- (2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the Punjab Minimum Wages Rules, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in Form I, for the brackets, figures and word "[Rule 21(4)]", the brackets, figures and words "[See rule 21(4)]" shall be substituted.
- 3. In the said rules, in Form II, for the brackets, figures and word "[Rule 21(4)]", the brackets, figures and words "[See rule 21(4)]" shall be substituted.
- **4.** In the said rules, in Form II-A, for the figure, letter and word "FORM II-A", the following shall be substituted, namely:-
