No. Labour-Lab0MISC/64/2021-5L/I/449712 To enable the employees working in the Shops and Commercial Establishments situated in the State of Punjab who are voters of Haryana to cast their votes in 47-Adampur Assembly constituency in Haryana, it is considered in public interest to declare 3rd November, 2022 as a paid holiday within the revenue jurisdiction of the districts adjoining the areas of Haryana State.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by second proviso to sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958 (Punjab Act No. 15 of 1958) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to fix Thursday, falling on 3rd November, 2022 to be a 'closed day' for the employees who are voters of Haryana working in Shops and Commercial Establishments in the adjoining State of Punjab. However, 3rd November, 2022 (Thursday) shall not be a 'closed day' in lieu of weekly off falling between 31st October, 2022 and 6th November, 2022.
